BOGOTA, D.C. AUGUST 30, 2019. - Cemex Latam Holdings, S.A. ("CLH") informs that its subsidiary Cemex Colombia S.A. ("CEMEX Colombia") reported as relevant information that the municipality of Ibagué-Tolima (the "Municipality"), ordered the dismissal of the special-requirement file related to the levy of the industry and commerce tax (ICA) for the year 2016, by which it pretended the payment of nineteen billion seven hundred sixty-three million nine hundred four thousand Colombian pesos (COP\$19,763,904,000), equivalent to USD\$5,766,627 converted using the Market Representative Exchange Rate (TRM) for today, in the terms reported to the market on April 23, 2019.

The Municipality dismissed the requirement because the evidence provided by CEMEX Colombia was sufficient to prove that the declared deductions correspond to sales deductions duly justified and to income declared in municipalities different than Ibagué, therefore this process is considered closed without CEMEX Colombia having to pay additional taxes, or any penalty.
