CEMEX LATAM HOLDINGS, S.A.
INFORMS

BOGOTÁ, D.C. APRIL 27, 2020. - CEMEX Latam Holdings, S.A. ("CLH") (BVC: CLH) informs that its subsidiary CEMEX COLOMBIA S.A. ("CEMEX Colombia" or "the Company") will resume most of its operations starting April 27, 2020, in compliance with the new disposals adopted by the National Government through the issuance of the Decree 593 of April 24, 2020, which allows the Company to supply materials and construction supplies that are necessary for the execution of infrastructure works, public works and building construction, among others. CEMEX Colombia expects to fully reactivate its operations indefinitely, subject to future decisions by the Colombian Government.

In order to start safely its activities, CEMEX Colombia is registering and implementing biosafety protocols aimed to mitigate the risks resulting from the COVID 19 spread, which have been designed in compliance with the state requirements contained mainly in the Joint Circular No. 001 of 2020 issued by the Housing, Health and Labor Ministries, the Joint Circular No. 003 of 2020 issued by the Health, Transport and Labor Ministries and Resolution No. 666 issued by the Health Ministry, and in general with the local requirements that have been published, as well as those that will be published in the future in each municipality where the Company operates. Compliance with these standards will be equally and strictly required of its employees, customers and suppliers. Likewise, those employees whose attendance at the Company's facilities is not necessary for the performance of their functions, will continue to work through the telework modality.

Moreover, CEMENTO BAYANO S.A., CLH's subsidiary in Panama will continue to have its operations suspended until May 24, in accordance with the new disposal issued by the National Government (Executive Decree 548 of April 24, 2020), date in which it expects to be able to resume certain operations on a regular basis and supply its products and services to its clients, when the situation allows so and the authorities so determine.

For CLH, the preservation of the health of its employees, customers, suppliers and the entire population continues to be a priority, as well as its commitment to continue contributing to the construction of a better future with the countries where it operates, providing to economic growth, employment generation and social welfare of the region.
